## SERVICES AVAILABLE

### • LEVEL 1 SUPPORT £300

You will receive:

- A Solution Focused Consultation to review current plans and provision and to develop strategies, provision and interventions.
- A short report with outcomes and strategies to inform Person Centred or Behaviour Support Plans.
- Follow up virtual meeting to assess impact and review effectiveness of plan within 6 weeks.

### • LEVEL 2 SUPPORT £540

You will receive Level 1 Support plus:

- Bespoke upskilling training/modelling for staff to support delivery of strategies and interventions within the plan.

### • LEVEL 3 SUPPORT £750

You will receive Level 2 Support plus:

- Virtual check ins fortnightly with a key member of staff to discuss and review progress and monitor concerns.
- Review in school to monitor progress and effectiveness of plan in 8-12 weeks as needed.



Permanent and Fixed Term Exclusions have risen since 2014 and outcomes of excluded children are often poor (Timpson Review, 2019). Children with some types of SEN, boys, those who have been supported by social care or are disadvantaged are all consistently more likely to be excluded from school than those without these characteristics.

Exclusion guidance indicates that early intervention and assessment for both children and young people who have SEN or display persistent disruptive behaviour

should be sought by schools to support children and young people to ensure needs are met and reduce the risks of exclusion.
