U5 Religion, crime and punishment


Looking at how religion feels towards punishment such as prison and capital punishment. **Understanding why different** religions believe why people commit crime.








The largest religious groups worldwide

Adapting on from previous knowledge and exploring Judaism more in-depth with critical questions and looking at extracts from the Torah to practice exam style questions.




Looking at exams tyle questions and focusing on parables from the bible to have a deeper understanding of Christianity.
